**AN ACT CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF CALIFORNIA VEHICLE
EMISSION STANDARDS AND THE UTILIZATION OF UNITED STATES
ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY VEHICLE EMISSIONS
STANDARDS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to repeal the requirement that
- 2 the state's vehicle emission standards follow such standards established
- 3 by the state of California and require such standards to be based on
- 4 those established by the United States Environmental Protection
- 5 Agency
