AN ACT PROHIBITING STATE AGENCIES FROM ADVERTISING, PROMOTING OR OTHERWISE ADVOCATING ON BEHALF OF CONNECTICUT'S RECREATIONAL CANNABIS INDUSTRY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that no state agency,
- 2 including, but not limited to, the Department of Consumer Protection,
- 3 shall advertise, promote or otherwise advocate on behalf of
- 4 Connecticut's recreational cannabis industry.
