AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE COSTS AND BENEFITS OF EXPANDING STATE-FUNDED ASSISTED LIVING SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Social Services to study the costs and benefits of
- 3 expanding state-funded assisted living services for persons who qualify
- 4 for the state-funded Connecticut home-care program for the elderly but
- 5 do not qualify for Medicaid.

Statement of Purpose:

To enhance the range of options for housing and support services for elderly persons.
