AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY INSURANCE LAWS IN NEIGHBORING STATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to require that the
- 2 Insurance Department (1) conduct a study evaluating automobile
- 3 liability insurance laws in neighboring states, including, but not limited
- 4 to, issues relating to coverage and practices to lower automobile liability
- 5 insurance premiums, and (2) submit a report of the findings of such
- 6 study to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
- 7 cognizance of matters relating to insurance.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that the Insurance Department (1) conduct a study evaluating automobile liability insurance laws in neighboring states, including, but not limited to, issues relating to coverage and practices to lower automobile liability insurance premiums, and (2) submit a report of the findings of such study to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to insurance.
