## AN ACT CONCERNING DEFINITIONS AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA PERTAINING TO SERVICES FOR PERSONS WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 17a of the general statutes be amended to require the 2 Commissioner of Developmental Services to implement the 3 recommendations of a November 15, 2024, report commissioned by the 4 Office of Policy and Management concerning the definition of 5 "intellectual disability" and the use of intelligence quotient (IQ) scores 6 in determining eligibility for state-funded services.

## Statement of Purpose:

To modify the definition of "intellectual disability" and to remove IQ scores as a component of eligibility for state-funded services.
