AN ACT CONCERNING THE INCLUSION OF READING PROFICIENCY AS A HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-221a of the general statutes be amended to include as
- 2 part of the high school graduation requirements a minimum reading
- 3 proficiency standard that each student be able to read at an eighth-grade
- 4 level in order to graduate from high school.

Statement of Purpose:

To require high school graduates to be able to read at a minimum of an eighth-grade reading level.
