**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PILOT
PROGRAM FOR AT-RISK YOUTH.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Education to establish a pilot program for at-risk youth in grades six to
- 3 eight, inclusive, to engage in hands-on, project-based learning programs
- 4 in the core academic curriculum subjects of mathematics, science,
- 5 English language arts and social studies that align academic content
- 6 with practical applications, including vocational and community
- 7 experience.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a pilot program for at-risk youth in grades six to eight,
inclusive, to engage in hands-on, project-based learning programs that
align academic content with practical applications, including vocational
and community experience.
