AN ACT CONCERNING THE ZERO-EMISSION AFTERMARKET CONVERSION PROJECT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require: (1) The state to 2 establish the Zero-Emission Aftermarket Conversion Project and create 3 a Clean Vehicle Rebate Project to provide an applicant who is a resident 4 of the state with a rebate for an eligible vehicle that has been converted 5 into a zero-emission vehicle; (2) the rebate issued pursuant to such 6 project shall be limited to one per vehicle and have a value of not more 7 than two thousand dollars; and (3) the state to establish guidelines and 8 eligibility criteria for the program.

Statement of Purpose:
