**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ZERO-EMISSION AFTERMARKET  
CONVERSION PROJECT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require: (1) The state to
- 2 establish the Zero-Emission Aftermarket Conversion Project and create
- 3 a Clean Vehicle Rebate Project to provide an applicant who is a resident
- 4 of the state with a rebate for an eligible vehicle that has been converted
- 5 into a zero-emission vehicle; (2) the rebate issued pursuant to such
- 6 project shall be limited to one per vehicle and have a value of not more
- 7 than two thousand dollars; and (3) the state to establish guidelines and
- 8 eligibility criteria for the program.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To establish the Zero-Emission Aftermarket Conversion Project.
