AN ACT CONCERNING THE EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-704e of the general statutes be amended to increase
- 2 the applicable percentage of the earned income tax credit to forty-one
- 3 and one-half per cent of the federal earned income tax credit and allow
- 4 households earning less than three hundred per cent of the federal
- 5 poverty levels to claim such credit.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the applicable percentage of the earned income tax credit to forty-one and one-half per cent of the federal earned income tax credit and allow households earning less than three hundred per cent of the federal poverty levels to claim such credit.
