AN ACT DESIGNATING NEUROFIBROMATOSIS AWARENESS DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-29a of the general statutes be amended to designate
- 2 February fourteenth of each year as Neurofibromatosis Awareness Day,
- 3 to raise awareness of this genetic condition that often begins in
- 4 childhood and causes tumors to grow on nerves throughout the body
- 5 and also may affect development of the brain, cardiovascular system,
- 6 bones and skin.

Statement of Purpose:

To designate February fourteenth of each year as Neurofibromatosis Awareness Day.
