**AN ACT CONCERNING LIQUOR PERMITS ISSUED TO HERITAGE
RAILROADS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 30 of the general statutes be amended to permit a heritage
- 2 railroad to sell alcoholic liquor for on-premises consumption in
- 3 exchange for a one-hundred-dollar fee for a six-month permit or a two-
- 4 hundred-dollar fee for an annual permit.
