AN ACT CONCERNING PAROLE ELIGIBILITY FOR AN INDIVIDUAL SERVING A LENGTHY SENTENCE FOR A CRIME COMMITTED BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL REACHED THE AGE OF TWENTY-FIVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 54 of the general statutes be amended to broaden eligibility
- 2 for parole to include those individuals serving long sentences for crimes
- 3 committed before the individual was twenty-five years of age, under
- 4 certain circumstances.

To broaden eligibility for parole to include those individuals serving long sentences for crimes committed before the individual was twentyfive years of age, under certain circumstances.
