***AN ACT CONCERNING THE REMOVAL OF CERTAIN LIMITATIONS
ON THE REEMPLOYMENT OF RETIRED TEACHERS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-183v of the general statutes be amended to permit
- 2 retired teachers to be reemployed in a position that does not require a
- 3 092 or 093 endorsement by a local or regional board of education
- 4 without limitations on such retired teacher's duration of employment,
- 5 the number of hours such retired teacher may work, the salary that such
- 6 retired teacher may earn, their eligibility in the teachers' retirement
- 7 system and additional employment benefits offered by such board of
- 8 education, including health insurance.

Statement of Purpose:

To address teacher shortages by removing certain limitations on the reemployment of retired teachers.
