AN ACT CONCERNING THE INCLUSION OF CIVICS EDUCATION AS PART OF SPECIAL EDUCATION INSTRUCTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to (1) include civics 2 education as part of the special education instruction and curriculum to 3 provide students with special needs instruction on civic rights and 4 responsibilities, (2) provide funding to support schools in developing or 5 adapting civics courses specifically designed for accessibility and 6 engagement for special needs students, and (3) create an inclusive 7 educational environment that encourages students with special needs 8 to participate fully in civic life.

Statement of Purpose:

To create an inclusive educational environment that encourages students with special needs to participate fully in civic life.
