AN ACT CONCERNING THE INSTRUCTION OF AFRICAN-AMERICAN AND BLACK STUDIES AND PUERTO RICAN AND LATINO STUDIES IN MIDDLE SCHOOL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-16ss of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 African-American and Black studies and Puerto Rican and Latino
- 3 studies be included in the curriculum of students in grade six to eight,
- 4 inclusive.

Statement of Purpose:

To promote diversity, inclusion and cultural awareness by integrating African-American and Black and Puerto Rican and Latino studies into the educational experience of middle school students across Connecticut.
