AN ACT CONCERNING COMPLIANCE WITH ENVIRONMENTAL AND WATER QUALITY REGULATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) encourage investments in
- 2 water infrastructure projects that are required for state and federal
- 3 regulatory compliance, and (2) authorize a surcharge for certain water
- 4 infrastructure projects that provide environmental and public health
- 5 benefits, including, but not limited to, addressing PFAS contamination.
