AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE TO ERECT A STATUTE HONORING MAYOR THIRMAN MILNER IN THE CITY OF HARTFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the Office of Policy and Management for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to the city of Hartford to erect a statute in honor of Mayor Thirman Milner near the
- 7 intersection of Russ Street and Lafayette Street in such city.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding to erect a statute in honor of Mayor Thirman Milner, the first African American mayor in New England, in the city of Hartford.
