AN ACT CONCERNING RETAILERS' USE OF THE PHRASE "DOLLAR STORE".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that no retailer
- 2 doing business in this state shall hold itself out as a "dollar store" unless
- 3 a significant majority of the goods such retailer offers to consumers are
- 4 priced at or below one dollar.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that retailers more accurately employ the phrase "dollar store".
