**AN ACT RESTRICTING SALES OF NITROUS OXIDE TO LICENSED
HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS AND REGULATED INDUSTRIAL
ENTITIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that no person shall
- 2 offer, sell or transfer nitrous oxide to any other person unless such other
- 3 person is (1) a licensed health care provider who intends to use the
- 4 nitrous oxide for health care purposes, or (2) a regulated industrial
- 5 entity that intends to use the nitrous oxide for legitimate industrial
- 6 purposes and not as an intoxicant.

Statement of Purpose:

To restrict offers, sales and transfers of nitrous oxide to (1) licensed
health care providers for health care purposes, and (2) regulated
industrial entities for legitimate industrial purposes.
