AN ACT RESTRICTING SALES OF NITROUS OXIDE TO LICENSED HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS AND REGULATED INDUSTRIAL ENTITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to provide that no person shall offer, sell or transfer nitrous oxide to any other person unless such other person is (1) a licensed health care provider who intends to use the nitrous oxide for health care purposes, or (2) a regulated industrial entity that intends to use the nitrous oxide for legitimate industrial purposes and not as an intoxicant.

Statement of Purpose:

To restrict offers, sales and transfers of nitrous oxide to (1) licensed health care providers for health care purposes, and (2) regulated industrial entities for legitimate industrial purposes.
