AN ACT REQUIRING THE COMMISSIONER OF CONSUMER PROTECTION TO CONDUCT A SURVEY OF OTHER STATES' OCCUPATIONAL AND PROFESSIONAL TRAINING AND LICENSING REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner of
- 2 Consumer Protection to (1) conduct a survey of other states'
- 3 occupational and professional training and licensing requirements and
- 4 compare such other states' requirements to Connecticut's requirements,
- 5 and (2) upon completing such survey, submit a report outlining the
- 6 commissioner's findings to the joint standing committee of the General
- 7 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to consumer
- 8 protection.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Consumer Protection to (1) survey other states' occupational and professional training and licensing requirements and compare such other states' requirements to Connecticut's requirements, and (2) submit a report outlining the commissioner's findings.
