AN ACT CONCERNING ENHANCED PROTECTIONS FOR CONSUMERS UNDER THE UNIFORM COMMERCIAL CODE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 42a of the general statutes be amended to: (1) Expand the ways in which express warranties are created and available to consumers, (2) eliminate privity requirements, and (3) provide broad definitions of "product seller", "lessor" and "manufacturer" under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that consumers are not disadvantaged by outdated legal requirements under the Uniform Commercial Code.
