***AN ACT ESTABLISHING A VOLUNTEER MEDICAL LICENSE FOR
RETIRED PHYSICIANS SEEKING TO PROVIDE PRO BONO MEDICAL
SERVICES TO INDIGENT AND NEEDY PATIENTS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 370 of the general statutes be amended to establish a
- 2 volunteer medical license, to be issued without payment of any fee, for
- 3 physicians retired or retiring from the active practice of medicine who
- 4 seek to donate their expertise for the medical care and treatment of
- 5 indigent or needy patients in the clinical setting of a health care clinic
- 6 organized, in whole or in part, for the delivery of health care services
- 7 without charge.

Statement of Purpose:

To create a volunteer medical license for retired physicians who seek to provide pro bono medical services to indigent or needy patients.
