AN ACT ELIMINATING THE REQUIREMENT THAT FOOD PROTECTION MANAGERS AT CLASS 2 FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS PASS A TEST AS PART OF A FOOD PROTECTION MANAGER CERTIFICATION PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 19a-36i of the general statutes be amended to eliminate
- 2 the requirement that food protection managers at class 2 food
- 3 establishments satisfactorily pass a test as part of a food protection
- 4 manager certification program.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the requirement that food protection managers at class 2 food establishments satisfactorily pass a test as part of a food protection manager certification program.
