AN ACT CONCERNING THE AVAILABILITY OF MENSTRUAL PRODUCTS IN SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 10-212k of the general statutes be amended to (1) 2 eliminate the requirement that menstrual products be provided in men's 3 restrooms in high schools, (2) eliminate the requirement that menstrual 4 products be made available in all restrooms that are accessible to 5 students in grades three to eight, inclusive, and (3) require that 6 menstrual products be made available at a centralized location in a 7 school, such as the school nurse's office.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure the appropriate use of menstrual products provided to children in schools.
