**AN ACT CONCERNING THE AVAILABILITY OF MENSTRUAL
PRODUCTS IN SCHOOLS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-212k of the general statutes be amended to (1)
- 2 eliminate the requirement that menstrual products be provided in men's
- 3 restrooms in high schools, (2) eliminate the requirement that menstrual
- 4 products be made available in all restrooms that are accessible to
- 5 students in grades three to eight, inclusive, and (3) require that
- 6 menstrual products be made available at a centralized location in a
- 7 school, such as the school nurse's office.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure the appropriate use of menstrual products provided to
children in schools.
