AN ACT CONCERNING PARENTAL NOTIFICATION OF BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION MEETINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That section 10-236c of the general statutes be amended to require school officials to notify the parent or guardian of a student of any behavior intervention meeting concerning such student or such student's substantial and material disruption, injury, sign of mental health distress, new gender identity, commission of an act of bullying, or instance of such student's having been the target of bullying, and a pattern of poor performance or change of student's record.

Statement of Purpose:

To maintain parents' and guardians' involvement in their child's mental and emotional well-being at school and build closer working relationships among parents and guardians, teachers, staff and administrators to protect children and improve educational and emotional outcomes.
