AN ACT CONCERNING FRAUDULENT MISREPRESENTATION AS A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that any person who
- 2 fraudulently misrepresents that such person is a person with a disability
- 3 for the purpose of receiving accommodations regarding service dogs
- 4 afforded by the Americans with Disabilities Act shall be guilty of a
- 5 misdemeanor.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that any person who fraudulently misrepresents that such person is a person with a disability for the purpose of receiving accommodations regarding service dogs afforded by the Americans with Disabilities Act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
