***AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONSUMPTION OF CANNABIS IN A
MOTOR VEHICLE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That (1) section 54-33p of the general statutes be amended to allow a
2 police officer to use the odor of cannabis or burnt cannabis as a basis to
3 support any stop or search of a person or motor vehicle; (2) sections 53a-
4 213a and 53a-213b of the general statutes be amended to allow a police
5 officer to stop a motor vehicle if the driver or passenger is observed
6 consuming cannabis; (3) the general statutes be amended to require the
7 Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection and state and
8 local police departments to track data and statistics on cannabis-related
9 driving under the influence accidents and stop incidents and store such
10 data separately from alcohol-related incidents; and (4) the general
11 statutes be amended to (A) establish a statutory blood THC level at
12 which an individual may be charged with driving under the influence
13 for cannabis consumption, and (B) require consent for blood testing for

- 14 suspected cannabis or other drug-related driving under the influence
15 incidents as a condition for obtaining a motor vehicle operator's license.

Statement of Purpose:

To treat the use of cannabis in a motor vehicle in the same manner as the use of alcohol in a motor vehicle is treated.
