AN ACT CONCERNING CONSENT SEARCHES AND POLICE PURSUITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That (1) section 54-330 of the general statutes be amended to restore 2 a police officer's ability to request consent to search a motor vehicle 3 when the officer has a reasonable and articulable suspicion that a weapon, contraband or other evidence of a crime is contained within the 4 5 vehicle; and (2) chapter 104 of the general statutes be amended to 6 require the Police Officer Standards and Training Council to revise the 7 model pursuit policy to allow police officers to pursue individuals 8 suspected of committing certain property crimes.

To allow police pursuits and consent searches.
