AN ACT CONCERNING REVOCATION OF BOND FOR CERTAIN VIOLENT OFFENDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require the court to 2 automatically revoke a bond for any crime of violence if the defendant 3 reoffends by committing another violent offense while awaiting

4 disposition.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow courts to hold without bail individuals who are a danger to the community.
