**AN ACT CONCERNING THE MAINTENANCE OF RECORDS
COLLECTED BY LICENSE PLATE READERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapters 104 and 529 of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 provide that the state, a political subdivision of the state or a contractor
- 3 that receives state funds shall not maintain any record collected by a
- 4 license plate reader for more than seventy-two hours, except for any
- 5 such record that shows that a motor vehicle matches an alert on a list of
- 6 vehicles of interest or is requested pursuant to a warrant or court order.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect personal privacy by prohibiting the state, a political subdivision of the state or a contractor that receives state funds from maintaining certain records concerning motor vehicles.
