AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXPANSION OF THE CRISIS INITIATIVE PILOT PROGRAM THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require that, not later than 2 January 1, 2026, the Division of State Police within the Department of 3 Emergency Services and Public Protection, in conjunction with the 4 Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, (1) expand 5 throughout the state the pilot program known as the CRISIS Initiative: 6 Connection to Recovery through Intervention, Support and Initiating 7 Services, and (2) at a minimum, include as part of such expanded 8 program components of the pilot program that require training for state 9 police officers, coordination between state police officers and mental 10 health professionals and referrals to facilities for mental health services.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that police officers throughout the state have the proper training and resources when dealing with someone who is in distress.
