## AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAID COVERAGE FOR ALLERGY PREVENTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner of Social Services to provide Medicaid coverage, to the extent permissible under federal law, for allergen introduction dietary supplements for infants to prevent peanut and egg allergy development.

## Statement of Purpose:

To invest in food allergy prevention to reduce the long-term health care costs to the state, families and the health care system for treatment of and recovery from food allergies.
