**AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAID COVERAGE FOR ALLERGY PREVENTION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Social Services to provide Medicaid coverage, to the
- 3 extent permissible under federal law, for allergen introduction dietary
- 4 supplements for infants to prevent peanut and egg allergy
- 5 development.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To invest in food allergy prevention to reduce the long-term health care costs to the state, families and the health care system for treatment of and recovery from food allergies.
