AN ACT PROHIBITING HOMEOWNERS INSURANCE COMPANIES FROM DENYING COVERAGE TO PROPERTY OWNERS BASED ON THE BREED OF A TENANT'S DOG TRAINED AS A GUIDE OR ASSISTANCE DOG.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit homeowners 2 insurance companies from denying homeowners insurance coverage to 3 property owners based on the breed of a tenant's dog trained as a guide
- 4 or assistance dog when such property owner is required to allow such
- 5 tenant to have such dog pursuant to state or federal law.
