AN ACT CONCERNING THE ABILITY OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER TO USE THE ODOR OF CANNABIS AS A BASIS TO SUPPORT AN INVESTIGATORY MOTOR VEHICLE STOP OR SEARCH OF A MOTOR VEHICLE OR PERSON IN A MOTOR VEHICLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 54-33p of the general statutes be amended to restore the
- 2 ability of a law enforcement officer to use the odor of cannabis as a basis
- 3 to support an investigatory motor vehicle stop or search of a motor
- 4 vehicle or person in a motor vehicle.
