AN ACT CONCERNING UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS FOR STRIKING WORKERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subdivision (3) of subsection (a) of section 31-236 of the general
- 2 statutes be amended to allow workers to be eligible for unemployment
- 3 benefits for the duration of any labor dispute.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow striking workers to receive unemployment benefits for the duration of a strike.
