**AN ACT REQUIRING SPORTS WAGERING RETAILERS TO TAKE
CERTAIN ACTIONS IN RESPONSE TO SPORTS WAGERING
ERRORS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 229b of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 a sports wagering retailer shall, prior to the start of any sporting event
- 3 for which such retailer accepts any sports wagering and discovers any
- 4 error, (1) correct such error, (2) cancel any sports wagering impacted by
- 5 such error, and (3) fully refund all patrons impacted by such error.
