**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PILOT PROGRAM ALLOWING POLICE TO
USE A SYSTEM THAT LAUNCHES A GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM
DEVICE ONTO ANOTHER VEHICLE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) establish a pilot program
- 2 to allow three municipal police departments to install a system on their
- 3 police cruisers that permits a police officer to launch a global positioning
- 4 system device onto another vehicle, (2) provide grants to such
- 5 departments to implement the program, (3) require such departments
- 6 to submit a report regarding the utilization of such system to the Police
- 7 Officer Standards and Training Council, and (4) require said council to
- 8 submit a report summarizing the results of the pilot program and
- 9 making recommendations concerning any future utilization of such
- 10 system to the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having
- 11 cognizance of matters relating to public safety and the judiciary.

Statement of Purpose:

To implement a pilot program and provide funding to certain police
departments to install a system on police cruisers that permits a police

officer to launch a global positioning system device onto another vehicle, to enable police to track vehicles and apprehend auto thieves without a high-speed chase.
