**AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING TO ESTABLISH A CENTER FOR
NEUROMODULATION TREATMENT FOR VETERANS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of two million dollars be appropriated to the
- 2 Department of Public Health, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year
- 3 ending June 30, 2026, for a grant-in-aid to Hartford HealthCare
- 4 Rehabilitation Medicine Network to establish, in collaboration with The
- 5 University of Connecticut, a center of excellence for neuromodulation
- 6 treatment for veterans.
