AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR NUTRITION ASSISTANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That (1) the sum of ten million dollars be appropriated to the 2 Department of Social Services, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year 3 ending June 30, 2026, for the supplemental nutrition commodities 4 assistance program, established pursuant to section 17b-791 of the 5 general statutes, (2) such sum be increased by fifteen per cent each fiscal year thereafter, and (3) section 17b-791 of the general statutes be 6 7 amended to allow, rather than require, soup kitchens, food pantries and 8 emergency shelters to pay a handling fee of up to five cents per pound 9 to cover costs incurred by the Connecticut Food Bank.
