**AN ACT CONCERNING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CENTERS FOR  
DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION'S WHOLE SCHOOL, WHOLE  
COMMUNITY, WHOLE CHILD FRAMEWORK.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Department of Education and local and regional boards of education to
- 3 (1) use the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's Whole School,
- 4 Whole Community, Whole Child domains to map relevant or adjacent
- 5 policies, (2) review such map to identify areas of strength, as well as
- 6 areas of overlap or gap, (3) evaluate opportunities to cease
- 7 implementation of policies that are duplicative, outdated, ineffective or
- 8 unsustainable, (4) identify potential directions for action and expand
- 9 capacity of school wellness teams by broadening the definition of
- 10 "wellness" to include the whole child, (5) designate district and school
- 11 coordinators of the whole child wellness teams, including personnel
- 12 who can provide oversight over coordination and integration efforts,
- 13 and (6) expand upon the membership of existing wellness teams to
- 14 include diverse representation across such domains.

To implement the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's Whole School, Whole Community, Whole Child framework.
