AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF INFORMATION TO PET OWNERS DURING AND FOLLOWING AN INVESTIGATION OF ALLEGED WRONGDOING BY A VETERINARIAN TOWARD SUCH PET.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Subsections (b) and (c) of section 20-204a of the general
statutes are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof
(*Effective from passage*):

4 (b) Except as provided in subsections (c) and (d) of this section, the 5 investigation shall be confidential and not subject to disclosure under 6 section 1-210 and no person may disclose knowledge of the 7 investigation to a third party unless the veterinarian requests that the 8 investigation be open, except that the department shall provide 9 information [to the] both during and after any such investigation to: (1) 10 The person who filed the complaint pursuant to subdivision (12) of 11 subsection (a) of section 19a-14, and (2) the owner of any animal that is 12 the subject of any such investigation.

(c) If the department makes a finding of no probable cause to takeaction under section 20-202 or fails to make a finding within the twelve-

15 month period required by subsection (a) of this section, the allegation 16 submitted pursuant to subsection (a) of this section and the entire record 17 of the investigation may remain confidential and no person shall 18 disclose knowledge of such investigation to a third party unless the 19 veterinarian requests that it be open, except that the department shall 20 provide information [to the] both during and after any such 21 investigation to: (1) The person who filed the complaint pursuant to 22 subdivision (12) of subsection (a) of section 19a-14, and (2) the owner of 23 any animal that is the subject of any such investigation.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	from passage	20-204a(b) and (c)

Statement of Purpose:

To provide information to pet owners from the Department of Public Health during and following an agency investigation into allegations of wrongdoing by a veterinarian toward such pet.
