AN ACT PROHIBITING THE CLEARING OF FOREST LAND FOR GRID-SCALE SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) prohibit the clearing of
- 2 existing forest land for the purpose of developing grid-scale solar
- 3 photovoltaic projects, and (2) encourage the siting of such projects on
- 4 canopies, roofs, brownfields or on existing developed land uses.
