AN ACT CONCERNING INCENTIVES FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF RESIDENTIAL ELECTRIC RESISTANCE HEATING SYSTEMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to increase the rate of 2 replacement of residential electric resistance heating systems by (1) 3 identifying dwelling units that would benefit from such replacement, 4 and (2) requiring additional marketing and incentives for the 5 replacement of such systems.
