AN ACT CONCERNING BILLING FOR ELECTRICITY AT CUSTOMERS' FORMER PREMISES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 16 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit an electric
- 2 distribution company from billing a residential or business customer for
- 3 service provided to a premises after the company receives notice that
- 4 the residential or business customer no longer owns or rents such
- 5 premises.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent former building owners and tenants from being billed for electric service they do not use because they sold or moved out of the property.
