AN ACT REQUIRING LEGISLATIVE APPROVAL FOR THE COMBINED PUBLIC BENEFITS CHARGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) remove any charge
- 2 included in the charges collectively called the "Combined Public
- 3 Benefits Charge" from electric bills for end use customers of each electric
- 4 distribution company unless such charge is approved by the General
- 5 Assembly, and (2) require that any future such charge be implemented
- 6 only upon the affirmative vote of the General Assembly.

Statement of Purpose:

To repeal any component of the Combined Public Benefits Charge not approved by the General Assembly and require future charges be approved by the General Assembly.
