AN ACT CONCERNING THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE AND A STATE-WIDE AUDIT OF VOTER RECORDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (a) of section 9-21a of the general statutes be 2 amended to require the Secretary of the State, at least once every four
- 3 years, to audit the computerized voter registration records of the state
- 4 to remove from such records deceased individuals and individuals who
- 5 have moved out of the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Secretary of the State to regularly update the state's computerized voter registration records to no longer reflect deceased individuals and individuals who have moved out of the state.
